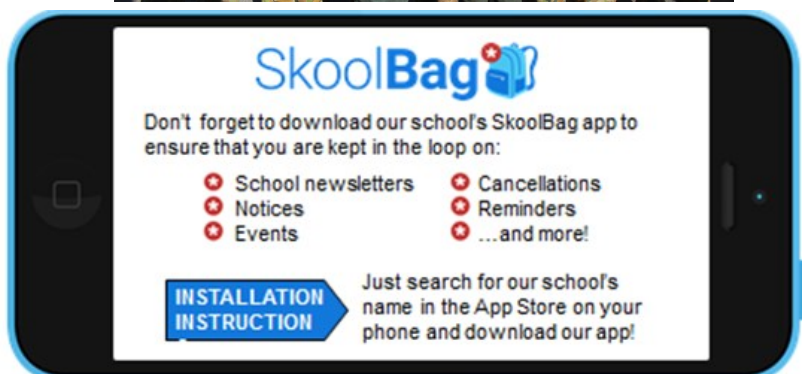


ANZAC Day 2018
