

# Stage 3

Stage 3 have been working very hard during the middle session in their math rotation activities. We currently have a focus on multiplication and division. The students have been learning their times tables, how to multiply increasingly larger numbers, share equally and this week they will begin learning about long division. Maths is such a fun part of the day as the students are able to have fun all while learning with hands-on activities and games.



In the mornings during our Literacy block stage 3 has been working on building their reading and writing skills. We have spent a lot of time breaking down persuasive texts, focusing on the techniques and structure that make a good piece of persuasive writing. This week students used their laptops to type their writing using Word Doc and wrote a persuasive piece on whether dogs or cats make better pets? We have also been working on other literacy skills such as spelling, grammar and punctuation and comprehension through a range of activities such as scattergories, visualising/drawing activities and soundwaves spelling games.
