Kindergarten have been learning about Living Things. They had a great time exploring our school environment looking for things that are alive and have planted some seeds to care for.

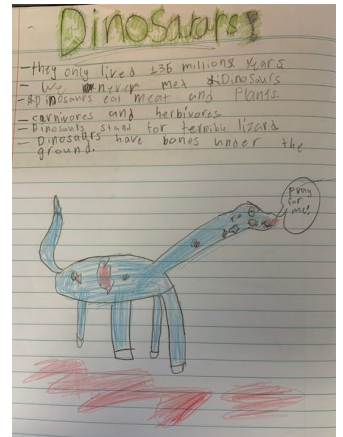
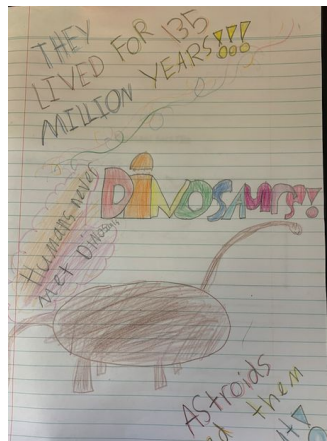
We have also been reading some Aboriginal Dreamtime stories with illustrations created by children. The students have enjoyed painting their own pictures to go with the stories.

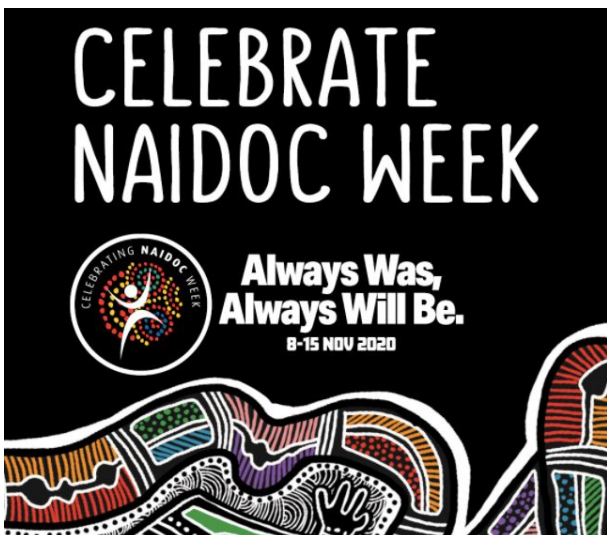




# Attendance Information and Updates

## **STUDENT ABSENCES**

The Department of Education requires parents and carers to provide an explanation of student absences. This can be done by phoning the school or completing a written note. When completing a student absence note due to illness, a reason of 'sick' or 'unwell' is not sufficient and requires further explanation. If your child will be absent for more than two consecutive days, please phone the office on 4295 1657 to notify of the absence reason. If your child is absent for 3 or more days, a doctor's certificate is required.
